Open Floor:

LCpl Jordan Haerter Veterans Memorial Bridge

- Named for a Sag Harbor veteran and resident who was Killed in Action in 2008
 - Website: www.injordanshonor.com/
- Was originally painted/graffitied (uncommissioned) by a local graffiti artist in Jordan's honor
 - It has since been defaced and is a spot where youth go to engage in high risk activities: drugs, alcohol, etc.
 - Not well lit area
 - Kym met a Sag Harbor resident who was speaking about the defaced graffiti under the bridge
 - Jackie shared that a SAFE youth team identified this area as a high-risk zone a few years ago in community mapping at CADCA
- o Is this a possible environmental strategy/community improvement
 - Physical design environmental strategy add lighting, other things to deter youth from congregating down there to engage in high risk activities
 - How? Who is needed?
 - Seek collaboration from Jordan's mother (JoAnn Lyles Cheryl has her contact info) to repaint the graffiti wall in Jordan's honor as well as other Sag Harbor veterans too?
 - Light the bridge purple for Recovery Month?
 - Ask Mayor LaRocca/Village trustees?
 - Who else in Sag Harbor would we need official permission, etc. from?
 - Mayor LaRocca, probably NYS as the bridge is part of NYS Route 114)
 - Find a local artist
 - Find the original graffiti artist (word was the original artist was Jimmy Kelly - not sure if he's still around, but can ask) or a new artist and work with them to design and put up a new mural (maybe as a match)?
 - Reasoning: A mural will hopefully deter immediate vandalism, unlike a painted wall
 - Good community service opportunity for local youth, girl scouts, boy scouts, etc. help with painting, etc.
 - Possibly coincide with Veterans Day optimistic goal of Nov 2023 if we are including helping add lighting to the area
